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Montesoffio

The location

The medieval village of Barchi is located 20 km from the Adriatic Sea amidst a mixture of gentle hills and small settlements nestled on the slopes of the towering peaks that make up the beautiful landscape of Pesaro-Urbino. Three kilometres further, at the end of a white road, lies our house in the sun. A 6,5 ha. big estate with a vineyard and many olive and fruit trees and a delicious swimming pool with panoramic views.



Our apartments and Bed&Breakfast rooms

For our guests we have 6 comfortable two-room apartments and 2 three-room apartments that will accommodate up to six persons and 4 splendid B&B rooms available. All apartments (40 - 60 m²) have their entrance on the ground floor. They all feature a combination of living-dining and kitchen area and one or two bedrooms. All bathrooms have a spacious shower and some a bath. One of our apartments is equipped to accommodate disabled guests. In the garden All bedrooms have screens and good, fresh beds. In this healthy and silent environment you will be sleeping like a rose.



Good food and drinks

Le Marche

Nature and landscape

The Marche is known for its untouched undulating hills, sandy beaches and many traditional old medieval towns and villages. The coastline of Le Marche is 180 km and very varied, with pebble and sandy beaches and high cliffs. Located within Le Marche, in the Appennines, are two national parks - the Monte Sibillini and the Gran Sasso. In addition there are several nature-reserves and forest areas, which along with many of nature's other wonders you'll encounter, are home to the wild horses that roam the countryside.



Culture and history

Le Marche is a region rich in culture. Montesoffio is encircled by numerous extraordinary medieval towns and close to beautiful old coastal cities like Fano and Senigallia and the cities of Urbino and Jesi. The nearest towns are Barchi (3 km), Orciano (6 km), Mondavio (7 km) and Fossombrone (12 km). They offer a variety of cafes, quaint narrow streets, picturesque shops, and well-stocked (super)markets. You'll also find many good restaurants located in the area and festivals in the surrounding towns. All just around the corner!



Opera's and medieval festivals

Especially in the summer months there are many medieval and music festivals. Like the famous opera festivals of Pesaro (Rossini) and Macerata, or the (modern) music festivals of Fano and Perugia (Jazz). Also not to be missed are the many local food (sagre) and wine festivals, with truffles, olive oil and wine.



Out and about

Swimming in the sea at 23 km from our house or in our own swimming pool. Directly from Montesoffio you can go hiking, or mountainbiking. In the area you can ride horses and in the winter you can even go skiing. Playing golf is also popular in Le Marche; there are some golf courses not too far away.
